We will go over itinerary, estimates of cost, and expectations for the weekend.

Hosanna Breakfast 2019: Ash Wednesday has already come, and Easter is fast approaching. We will be having our annual Youth Fundraiser Breakfast on Palm Sunday again this year, April 14, and calling it the Hosanna Breakfast, to accommodate Spring Breakers! This is the biggest individual fundraiser for the youth ministry, and we need your help! There will be signup sheets on the tables in the Gathering Space beginning on Sunday, March 17 for you to donate all kinds of things.
